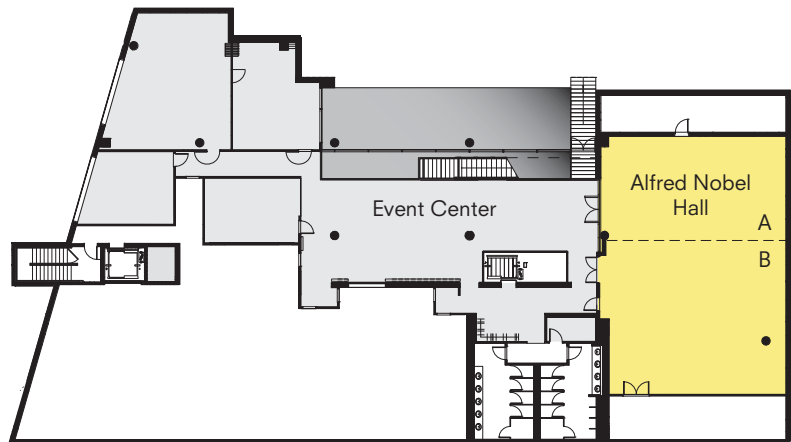


Alfred Nobel Hall

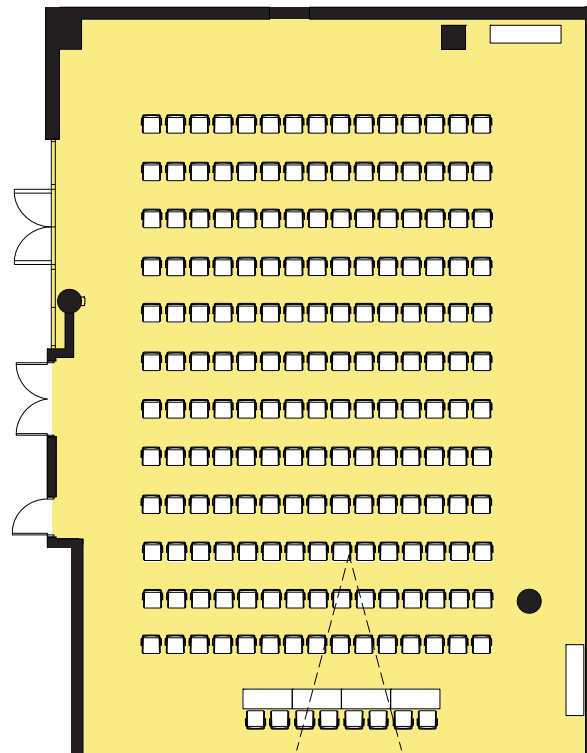

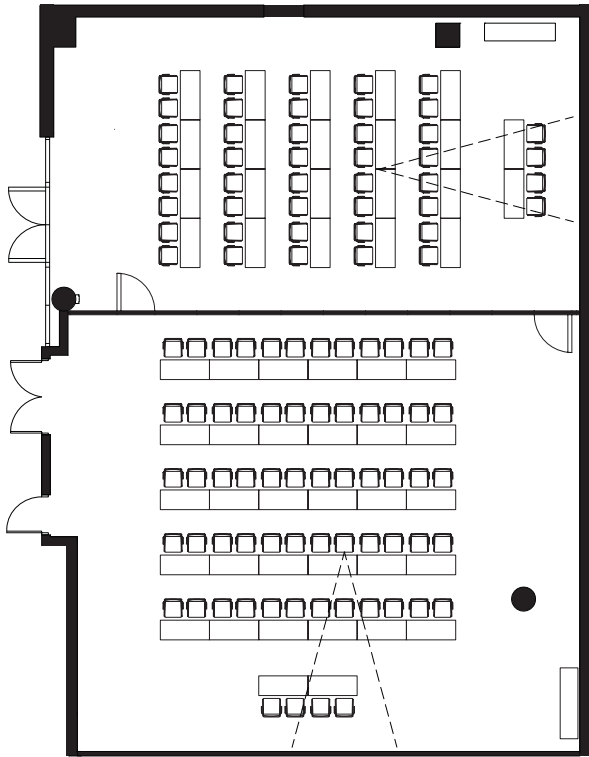

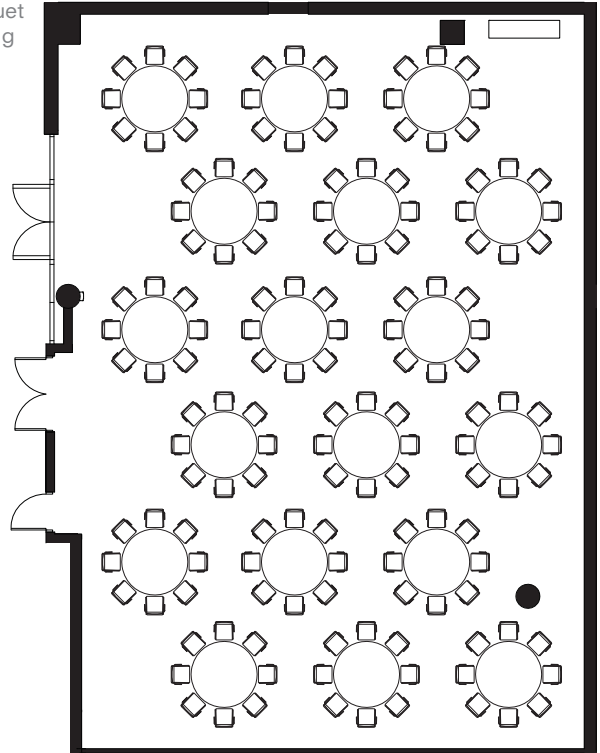


Classroom seating

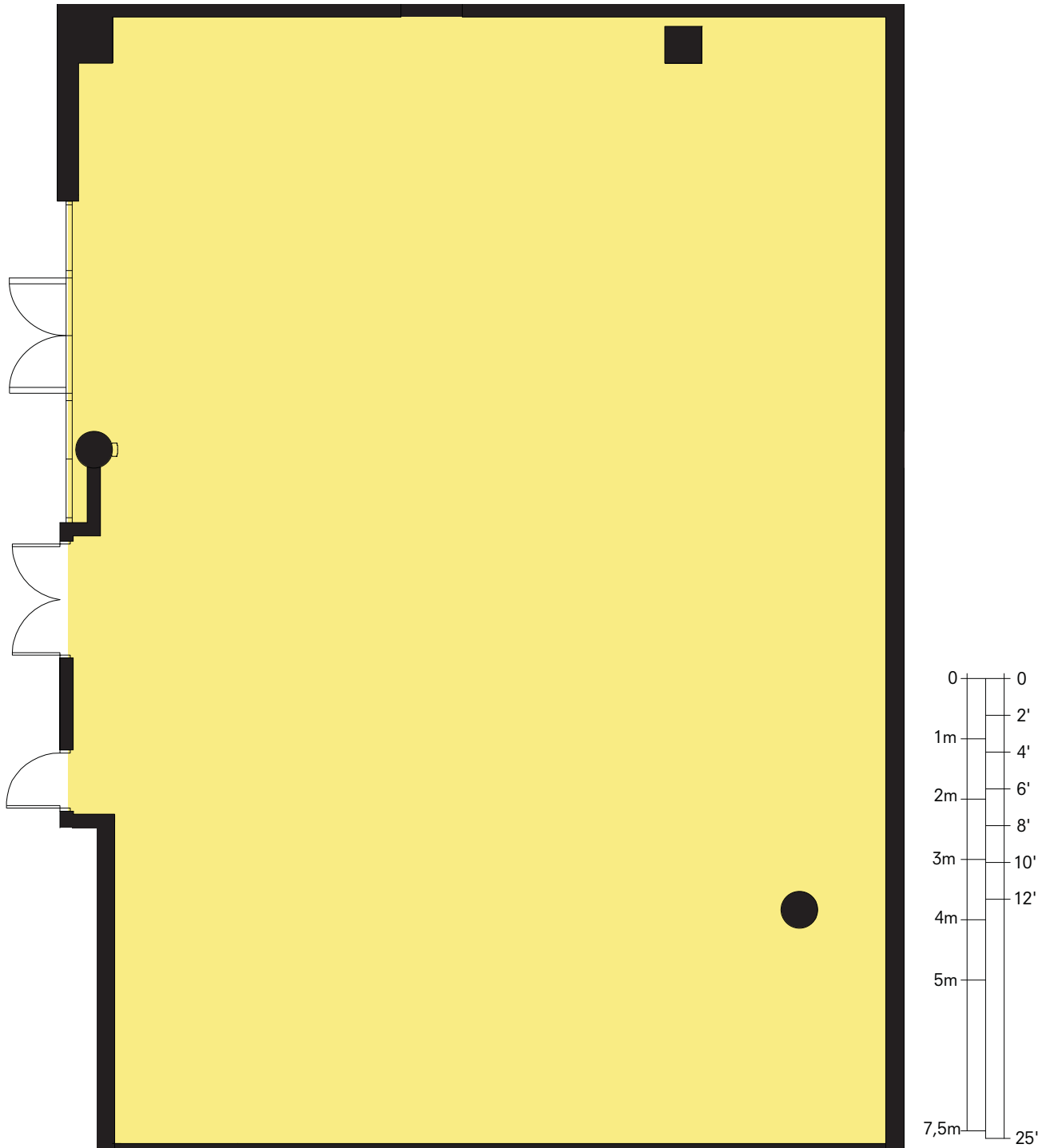
